Genesis 8:1-19 (NKJV)

<sup>1</sup> Then God remembered Noah, and every living thing, and all the animals that *were* with him in the ark. And God made a wind to pass over the earth, and the waters subsided. <sup>2</sup> The fountains of the deep and the windows of heaven were also stopped, and the rain from heaven was restrained. <sup>3</sup> And the waters receded continually from the earth. At the end of the hundred and fifty days the waters decreased. <sup>4</sup> Then the ark rested in the seventh month, the seventeenth day of the month, on the mountains of Ararat. <sup>5</sup> And the waters decreased continually until the tenth month. In the tenth *month*, on the first *day* of the month, the tops of the mountains were seen....

<sup>13</sup> And it came to pass in the six hundred and first year, in the first *month*, the first *day* of the month, that the waters were dried up from the earth; and Noah removed the covering of the ark and looked, and indeed the surface of the ground was dry. <sup>14</sup> And in the second month, on the twenty-seventh day of the month, the earth was dried.

<sup>15</sup> Then God spoke to Noah, saying, <sup>16</sup> "Go out of the ark, you and your wife, and your sons and your sons' wives with you. <sup>17</sup> Bring out with you every living thing of all flesh that *is* with you: birds and cattle and every creeping thing that creeps on the earth, so that they may abound on the earth, and be fruitful and multiply on the earth."

<sup>18</sup> So Noah went out, and his sons and his wife and his sons' wives with him. <sup>19</sup> Every animal, every creeping thing, every bird, *and* whatever creeps on the earth, according to their families, went out of the ark.
