The Heidelberg Catechism (Lord's Day 6).....read responsively

Q. 16 Why must he be very man, and also perfectly righteous?

A. **Because the justice of God requires that the same human nature which has sinned, should likewise make satisfaction for sin; and one, who is himself a sinner, cannot satisfy for others.**

Q. 17 Why must he in one person be also very God?

A. **That he might, by the power of his Godhead sustain in his human nature, the burden of God's wrath; and might obtain for, and restore to us, righteousness and life.**

Q. 18 Who then is that Mediator, who is in one person both very God, and a real righteous man?

A. **Our Lord Jesus Christ: "who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption."**

Q. 19 Whence knowest thou this?

A. **From the holy gospel, which God himself first revealed in Paradise; and afterwards published by the patriarchs and prophets, and represented by the sacrifices and other ceremonies of the law; and lastly, has fulfilled it by his only begotten Son.**

Genesis 22:15-24 (NKJV)

<sup>15</sup> Then the Angel of the LORD called to Abraham a second time out of heaven, <sup>16</sup> and said: "By Myself I have sworn, says the LORD, because you have done this thing, and have not withheld your son, your only *son* – <sup>17</sup> blessing I will bless you, and multiplying I will multiply your descendants as the stars of the heaven and as the sand which *is* on the seashore; and your descendants shall possess the gate of their enemies. <sup>18</sup> In your seed all the nations of the earth shall be blessed, because you have obeyed My voice." <sup>19</sup> So Abraham returned to his young men, and they rose and went together to Beersheba; and Abraham dwelt at Beersheba.

<sup>20</sup> Now it came to pass after these things that it was told Abraham, saying, "Indeed Milcah also has borne children to your brother Nahor: <sup>21</sup> Huz his firstborn, Buz his brother, Kemuel the father of Aram, <sup>22</sup> Chesed, Hazo, Pildash, Jidlaph, and Bethuel." <sup>23</sup> And Bethuel begot Rebekah. These eight Milcah bore to Nahor, Abraham's brother. <sup>24</sup> His concubine, whose name was Reumah, also bore Tebah, Gaham, Thahash, and Maachah.
