Genesis 24:28–67 (NKJV)

<sup>34</sup> So he said, “I *am* Abraham’s servant.... <sup>49</sup> Now if you will deal kindly and truly with my master, tell me. And if not, tell me, that I may turn to the right hand or to the left.”

<sup>50</sup> Then Laban and Bethuel answered and said, “The thing comes from the LORD; we cannot speak to you either bad or good. <sup>51</sup> Here *is* Rebekah before you; take *her* and go, and let her be your master’s son’s wife, as the LORD has spoken.”...

<sup>54</sup> And he and the men who *were* with him ate and drank and stayed all night. Then they arose in the morning, and he said, “Send me away to my master.” <sup>55</sup> But her brother and her mother said, “Let the young woman stay with us *a few* days, at least ten; after that she may go.”...

<sup>57</sup> So they said, “We will call the young woman and ask her personally.” <sup>58</sup> Then they called Rebekah and said to her, “Will you go with this man?” And she said, “I will go.”

<sup>59</sup> So they sent away Rebekah their sister and her nurse, and Abraham’s servant and his men. <sup>60</sup> And they blessed Rebekah and said to her: “Our sister, *may* you *become* *The mother of* thousands of ten thousands; And may your descendants possess The gates of those who hate them.”... <sup>61</sup> Then Rebekah and her maids arose, and they rode on the camels and followed the man. So the servant took Rebekah and departed.

<sup>62</sup> Now Isaac came from the way of Beer Lahai Roi, for he dwelt in the South. <sup>63</sup> And Isaac went out to meditate in the field in the evening; and he lifted his eyes and looked, and there, the camels *were* coming. <sup>64</sup> Then Rebekah lifted her eyes, and when she saw Isaac she dismounted from her camel; <sup>65</sup> for she had said to the servant, “Who *is* this man walking in the field to meet us?” The servant said, “It *is* my master.” So she took a veil and covered herself.

<sup>66</sup> And the servant told Isaac all the things that he had done. <sup>67</sup> Then Isaac brought her into his mother Sarah’s tent; and he took Rebekah and she became his wife, and he loved her. So Isaac was comforted after his mother’s *death*.
