CONFESSION OF SIN

Since the days of our fathers to this day we have been very guilty, and for our iniquities we have been delivered to humiliation, as it is this day.

And now for a little while grace has been shown from the Lord our God, to leave us a remnant to escape, and to give us a peg in His holy place, that our God may enlighten our eyes and give us a measure of revival in our bondage.

For we were slaves. Yet our God did not forsake us in our bondage; but He extended mercy to us to revive us.

And now, O our God, what shall we say after this? For we have forsaken Your commandments, which You commanded by Your servants the prophets.

And after all that has come upon us for our evil deeds and for our great guilt, since You our God have punished us less than our iniquities deserve, and have given us such deliverance as this,

should we again break Your commandments, and join with the people committing abominations?

Would You not be angry with us until You had consumed us, so that there would be no remnant or survivor?

O Lord God of Israel, You are righteous, for we are left as a remnant, as it is this day. Here we are before You, in our guilt, though no one can stand before You because of this.

The Heidelberg Catechism (Lord's Day 45).....read responsively

Q. 116 Why is prayer necessary for Christians?

A. **Because it is the chief part of thankfulness which God requires of us: and also, because God will give his grace and Holy Spirit to those only, who with sincere desires continually ask them of him, and are thankful for them.**

Q. 117 What are the requisites of that prayer, which is acceptable to God, and which he will hear?

A. **First, that we from the heart pray to the one true God only, who has manifested himself in his word, for all things, he has commanded us to ask of him; secondly, that we rightly and thoroughly know our need and misery, that so we may deeply humble ourselves in the presence of his divine majesty; thirdly, that we be fully persuaded that he, notwithstanding that we are unworthy of it, will, for the sake of Christ our Lord, certainly hear our prayer, as he has promised us in his word.**

Q. 118 What has God commanded us to ask of him?

A. **All things necessary for soul and body; which Christ our Lord has comprised in that prayer he himself has taught us.**

Q. 119 What are the words of that prayer?

A. **Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done on earth, as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, forever. Amen.**
