## CONFESSION OF SIN

A. **The second commandment is, Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of anything that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth: Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the Lord thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me; and showing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments.**

Q. 50. What is required in the second commandment?

Mark 6:14-29 (NASB)

<sup>14</sup> And King Herod heard *of it*, for His name had become well known; and *people* were saying, "John the Baptist has risen from the dead, and that is why these miraculous powers are at work in Him." <sup>15</sup> But others were saying, "He is Elijah." And others were saying, "*He is a prophet, like one of the prophets of old.*" <sup>16</sup> But when Herod heard *of it*, he kept saying, "John, whom I beheaded, has risen!" <sup>17</sup> For Herod himself had sent and had John arrested and bound in prison on account of Herodias, the wife of his brother Philip, because he had married her. <sup>18</sup> For John had been saying to Herod, "It is not lawful for you to have your brother's wife." <sup>19</sup> Herodias had a grudge against him and wanted to put him to death and could not *do so*; <sup>20</sup> for Herod was afraid of John, knowing that he was a righteous and holy man, and he kept him safe. And when he heard him, he was very perplexed; but he used to enjoy listening to him. <sup>21</sup> A strategic day came when Herod on his birthday gave a banquet for his lords and military commanders and the leading men of Galilee; <sup>22</sup> and when the daughter of Herodias herself came in and danced, she pleased Herod and his dinner guests; and the king said to the girl, "Ask me for whatever you want and I will give it to you." <sup>23</sup> And he swore to her, "Whatever you ask of me, I will give it to you; up to half of my kingdom." <sup>24</sup> And she went out and said to her mother, "What shall I ask for?" And she said, "The head of John the Baptist." <sup>25</sup> Immediately she came in a hurry to the king and asked, saying, "I want you to give me at once the head of John the Baptist on a platter." <sup>26</sup> And although the king was very sorry, *yet* because of his oaths and because of his dinner guests, he was unwilling to refuse her. <sup>27</sup> Immediately the king sent an executioner and commanded *him* to bring *back* his head. And he went and had him beheaded in the prison, <sup>28</sup> and brought his head on a platter, and gave it to the girl; and the girl gave it to her mother. <sup>29</sup> When his disciples heard *about this*, they came and took away his body and laid it in a tomb.
