**I renounce my sins, and pray the Lord to give me the strength to forsake them by his Holy Spirit.**

Mark 6:45-56 (NASB)

<sup>45</sup> Immediately Jesus made His disciples get into the boat and go ahead of Him to the other side to Bethsaida, while He Himself was sending the crowd away. <sup>46</sup> After bidding them farewell, He left for the mountain to pray. <sup>47</sup> When it was evening, the boat was in the middle of the sea, and He was alone on the land. <sup>48</sup> Seeing them straining at the oars, for the wind was against them, at about the fourth watch of the night He came to them, walking on the sea; and He intended to pass by them. <sup>49</sup> But when they saw Him walking on the sea, they supposed that it was a ghost, and cried out; <sup>50</sup> for they all saw Him and were terrified. But immediately He spoke with them and said to them, "Take courage; it is I, do not be afraid." <sup>51</sup> Then He got into the boat with them, and the wind stopped; and they were utterly astonished, <sup>52</sup> for they had not gained any insight from the *incident of the loaves*, but their heart was hardened. <sup>53</sup> When they had crossed over they came to land at Gennesaret, and moored to the shore. <sup>54</sup> When they got out of the boat, immediately *the people* recognized Him, <sup>55</sup> and ran about that whole country and began to carry here and there on their pallets those who were sick, to the place they heard He was. <sup>56</sup> Wherever He entered villages, or cities, or countryside, they were laying the sick in the market places, and imploring Him that they might just touch the fringe of His cloak; and as many as touched it were being cured.
